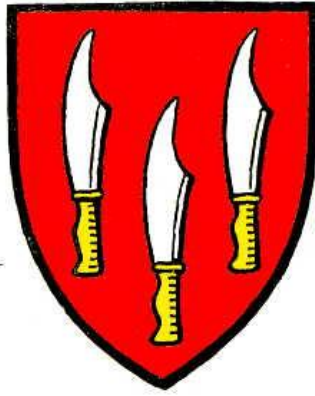

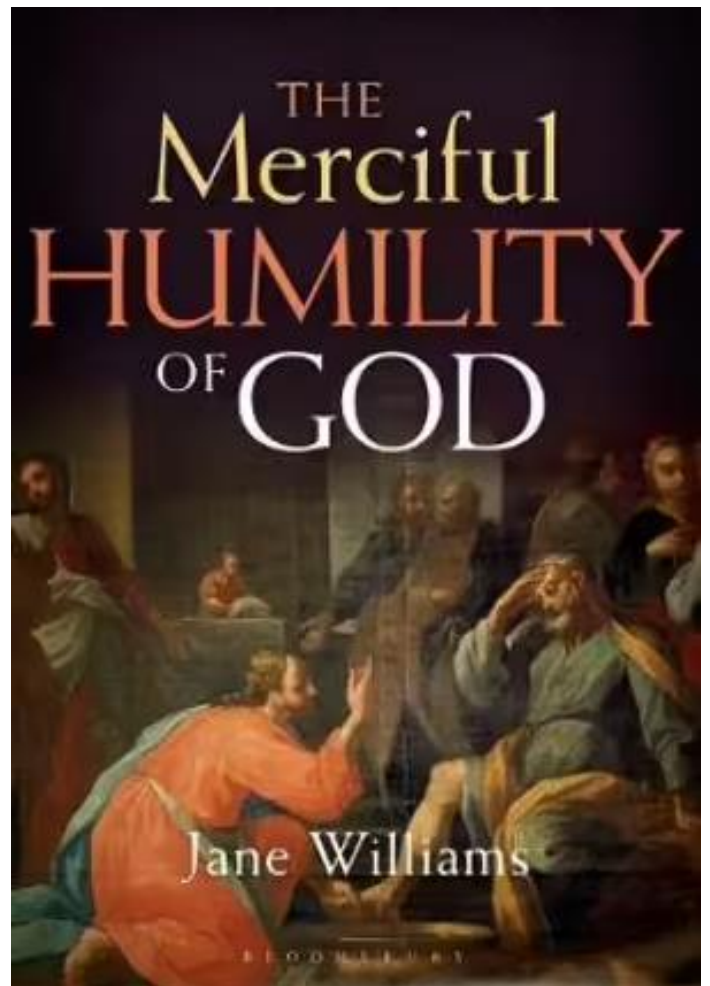
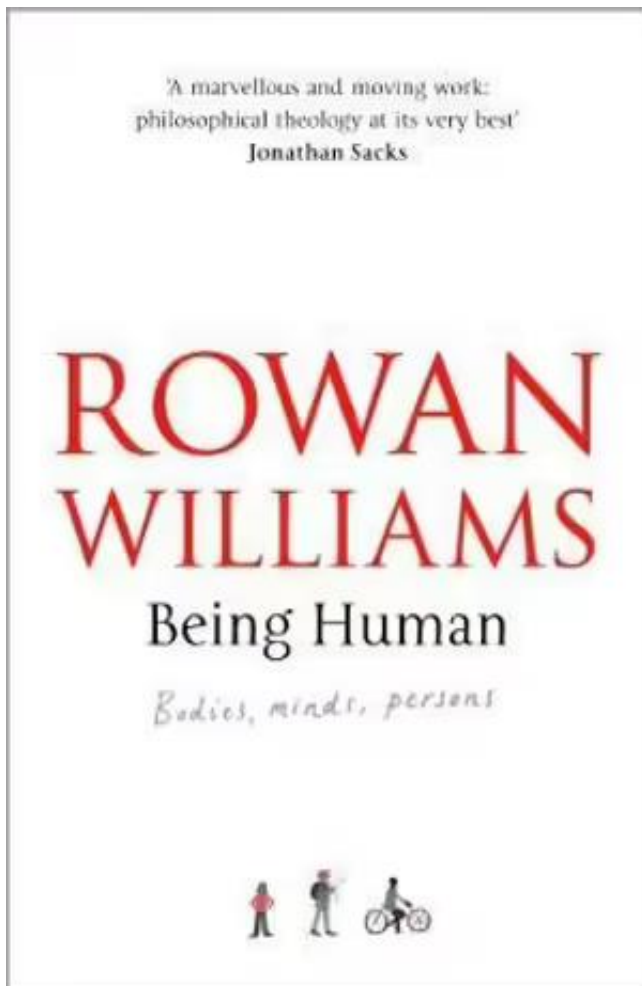

Parish Council Report to the Parish – February 2022

The new year has now begun in earnest for St Bart's Parish Council, which held its first 2022 meeting this past week.

Like all of us, the Parish Council is hopeful that this year will be better than the last two! The ravages of the Omicron variant certainly affected attendance at our Christmas services, but we are quietly confident that we will not face any further lockdowns. If that is the case, our wonderful Op Shop will be able to continue operating, and rents from the properties owned by the Richmond Church Lands Trust will return to something approaching normal. If our finances improve, then we will be able to plan for the re-opening of our social enterprise café.

In the meantime, the Parish Council discussed ways we might be able to open the café on, say, Saturdays, to keep the café's 'memory' alive in the community and offer some training to disadvantaged young people. Another footpath jumble sale in conjunction with the Op Shop and the Stepping Stones to Small Business program of the Brotherhood of St Laurence is in the mix. The café advisory committee will be meeting soon to canvass options. Watch this space!

Parish Council also heard that the Op Shop is short of volunteers, which is preventing it from opening on Mondays. If you are interested, please contact the Op Shop manager, Sandi Power, at [stbartsopshop 'at' gmail.com](mailto:stbartsopshop@gmail.com), or on 9429 7223. And please spread the word among your friends. Volunteering at the Op Shop is a great way to 'give back' to the community.

We also heard that more bellringers are needed. As one of only five Melbourne belltowers, St Bart's needs our peel to ring out more often. Churchwarden Jonathon Harrison, who is captain of our belltower, is on the lookout for experienced bellringers, and people interested in training for this fascinating role. He is also keen to hear from anyone interested in becoming servers in the liturgy.

Parish Council received the report of the inaugural meeting of the parish's new Climate Action Group, which is planning ways both the parish, and parishioners as individuals, can respond responsibly to the challenge of climate change. As Christians, we are mindful that we must protect and honour God's good creation.
